You may be eligible for a 'security rebate'

The Province of Manitoba is offering a \$300 rebate for homeowners and renters who purchase security equipment.

Eligible security improvements range from security cameras to permanent security fencing and other hardware items. Upgrades or replacements must be with new equipment, not used.

If you are a homeowner, you must provide proof of ownership (e.g. tax bill); if you are a renter,
